CLOSE-KNIT SMALL GROUPS

When a camper comes to Ferncliff, they are added into a small group of campers close to their age. We call these "family groups", each of which is assigned a color. Family groups go through their camp day and week together, joining with other family groups for meals, large group games, and worship. Through these small groups, campers build strong friendships with peers.

Why Three Prices?

Recognizing that families have different abilities to pay, Ferncliff has a voluntary three-tier fee program. You choose the tier that is most suitable for your family. No matter what tier you choose, the amenities, activities, and camp experience are the same. It's a way to make camp more affordable for more families.

TIER 1 is our **historically subsidized rate** and does not reflect the full cost of operating camp programs.

TIER !! is our **partially subsidized rate** for those who choose to pay a little more.

TIER III more closely reflects the actual cost of camp, including wear and tear of buildings and grounds.
